The album is a reflection of the times it was created as well as a wider view on things today. I believe some of my best work to-date is on this album...and I'm extremely proud of each and every song.





Story behind The Song!

Story behind The Song!

'Haunts Of Old'

This song took about 5 minutes to write! It was really that quick!

During the Pandemic, in 2020, I had been thinking about how I could reflect on the world, the times we were living through, but as always I wanted to write a song about more than just one thing. So I picked up my Hummingbird and strummed a few simple open chords... then that line 'Haunts Of Old' popped into my head... we were all locked in our homes, not able to go to our favourite bars, cafes, restaurants, parks etc. our favourite 'Haunts!' I was hooked, this would work!

I didn't even have time to grab my notebook & pencil... I just sang what came! 'All the places that I never thought I'd find nothing but an open door... all the faces that I've left behind... can't take it anymore...'

The lyric just came! I think this was one of the easiest lyrics I've written to date.

I literally just sang and the lines came out... magic!

I grabbed my phone and recorded the song idea before I wrote anything down... just so I didn't forget anything.

Then I wrote the lyrics down and set about arranging the song. Simple, was the by-word for the whole album and this song needed it really simple - to let the songwriting come front & centre.

The lines '...Time on my mind...' in the solo section actually took the longest time to get right! I think I was trying to write a whole bridge lyric that the song didn't need... before I sat back and just said to myself... 'Simple, dummy!' And the song was done...


